

#### The urgency to act


• Climate change **particularly affects the most vulnerable**, and reinforces existing inequalities, in particular in Africa, South Asia, Central America, and Small Island Developing States





#### Why a new Strategy?

- To align FAO's climate action with its new Strategic Framework, towards the achievement of the Agenda 2030 and its Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)
- To take into account the latest scientific evidence on climate change (IPCC reports) and how it affects agrifood systems



#### Three pillars to guide FAO action




### **Guiding principles**





#### Action Plan 2022 - 2025





to ensure the **successful implementation** of the Strategy and the **enhancement** of FAO climate action



**monitored in alignment** with the implementation of the PPAs of the Strategic Framework



reported on **every 2 years**, in alignment with FAO reporting cycle (next one in March 2024)



updated following a **mid-term review** of the Strategy in 2025


