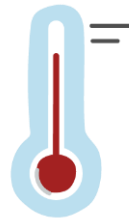

The urgency to act

- Climate change already has **severe impacts** on agrifood systems:

floods

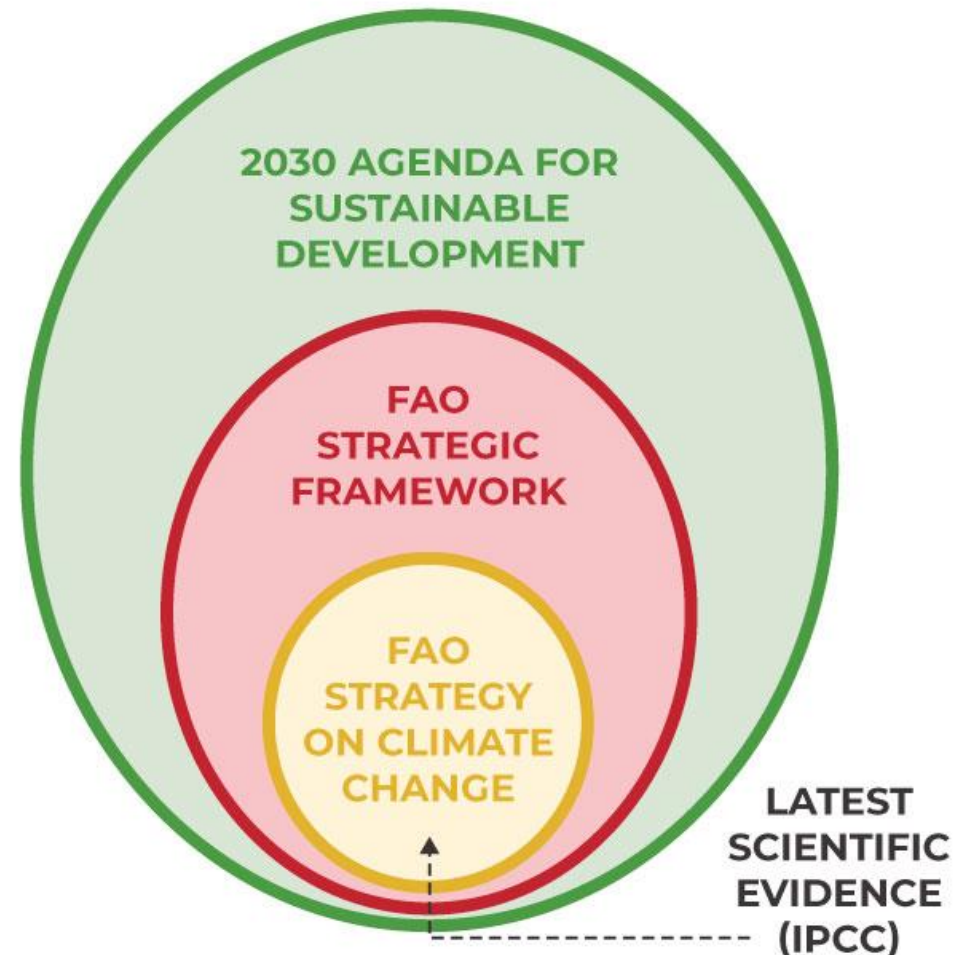
The urgency to act

- Climate change **particularly affects the most vulnerable**, and reinforces existing inequalities, in particular in Africa, South Asia, Central America, and Small Island Developing States



Why a new Strategy?

- To align FAO's climate action with its new **Strategic Framework**, towards the achievement of the **Agenda 2030** and its **Sustainable Development Goals** (SDGs)
- To take into account the **latest scientific evidence on climate change** (IPCC reports) and how it affects agrifood systems

Action Plan 2022 - 2025



to ensure the **successful implementation** of the Strategy and the **enhancement** of FAO climate action



monitored in alignment with the implementation of the PPAs of the Strategic Framework



reported on **every 2 years**, in alignment with FAO reporting cycle (next one in March 2024)



updated following a **mid-term review** of the Strategy in 2025

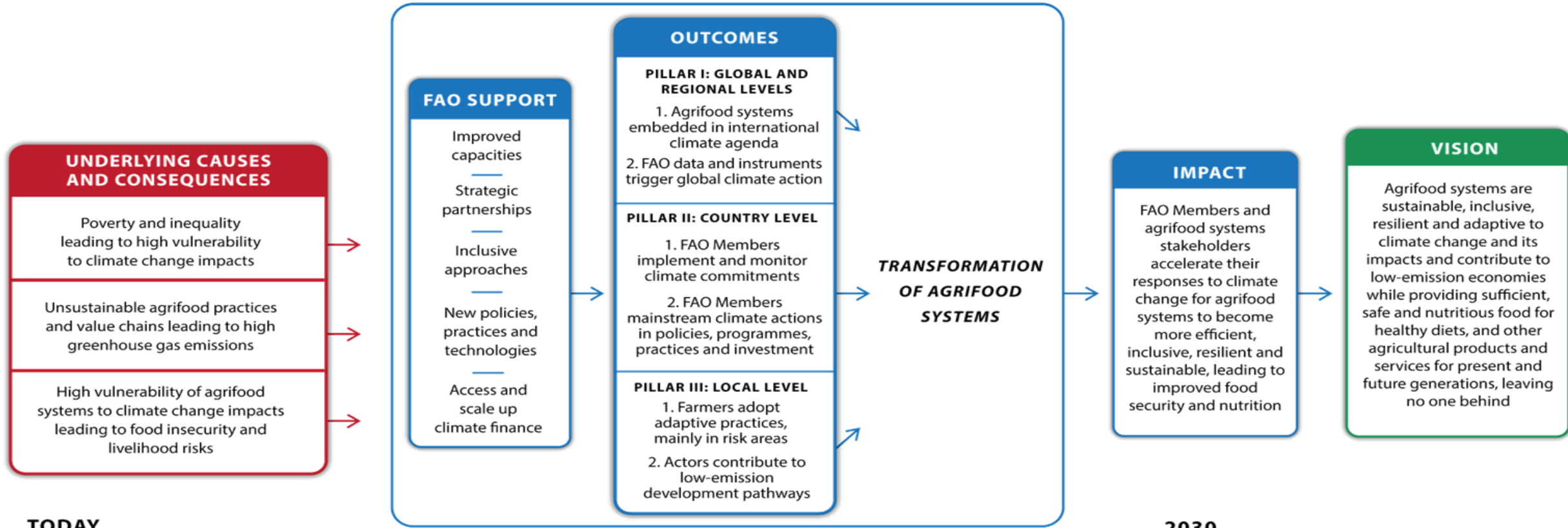
